Morning city tour with remainder of day is at leisure. Overnight in Toronto.

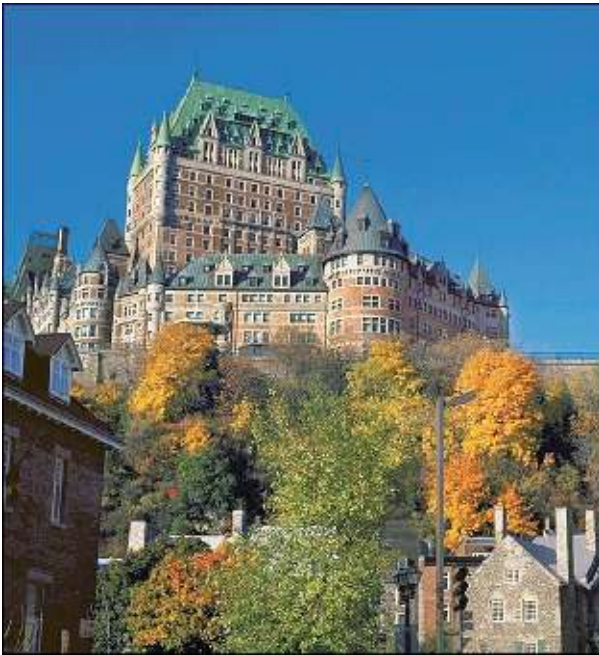
Day 3: Toronto - Montreal

Day 7: Quebec City - Ottawa

Day 8: Ottawa

Visit Turtle Island for unique celebration of contemporary native culture, followed by a city tour. Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Ottawa

Day 9: Ottawa - Midland

Visit Algonquin Provincial Park scenic trails, before continuing to Muskoka resort region. Overnight in Midland.





Day 10: Midland - Niagara Falls

Visit Sainte-Marie the Hurons, before heading south through orchards and vineyards to Niagara Falls with a boat ride to the foot of the waterfalls. Evening is at leisure. Overnight in Niagara Falls

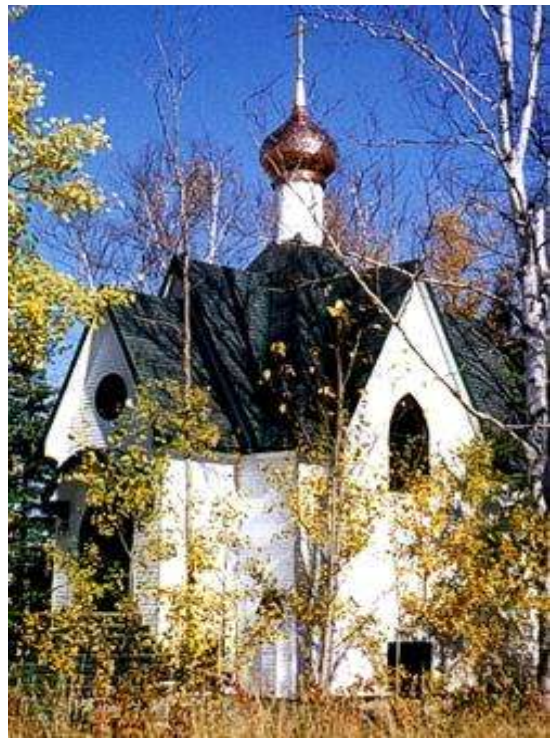


Day 11: Niagara Falls - Toronto
