Dynastic tombs, royal poetry reading pavilions over lotus ponds, mountains of marble, empty white sand beaches with the occasional bustling world-class metropolis, all add up to a mystical, magical, marvellous adventure in a land well-known yet unknown....



Day 01 : Arrival in Hanoi : Transfer to hotel. Mini orientation tour of Hoan Kiem Lake and Ngoc Son Temple. Continue to discover bustling streets of Old Quarter. Enjoy water puppet show follow by a dinner at local restaurant. Dinner and Overnight Hanoi.

Day 02 : Hanoi : Explore Hanoi, visit President Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum (closed on Mon & Fri), Museum of Ethnology, Temple of Literature, Museum of History. Afternoon transfer to Halong Bay with visit to Bat Trang ceramic village, famous for thousands of years, particularly dinnerware and ornamental ware. On arrival in Halong, transfer to hotel. Overnight Halong.



Day 03 : Halong Bay – Hanoi : Five hour boat trip on Ha Long Bay, World Heritage Site. Lunch on board. Magnificent view of bay of 3000 islands. Visit to Surprising Grotto, most beautiful in Halong and sea-bathing on Titov Island. Return to Hanoi. Overnight Hanoi.



Day 04 : Flight HANOI – HUE : Transfer to airport to take flight to Hue. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Visit Imperial Citadel and Dong Ba Market. Take a cyclo to Y Thao garden for dinner and traditional music performance. Overnight Hue.

Day 05 : Hue - Danang - Hoi An : Morning boat trip and visit Thien Mu Pagoda. Continue by car to visit Tu Duc and Khai Dinh's Mausoleums. Scenic drive to Hoi An with stops to visit Cham Museum and Marble Mountain in Danang. Check in hotel. Overnight Hoi An.

Day 06 : Hoi An : Morning walking tour of Hoi An including ancient houses, Japanese Covered Bridge, Phuc Kien Temple, Phung Hung House. Afternoon sampan ride along river front. Visit local factory to see how a lantern is made. Overnight Hoi An.

Day 07 : Hoi An - Qui Nhon : Drive to Qui Nhon with stops to visit Cham Towers en route. On arrival transfer to hotel. Overnight Qui Nhon.



Day 08 : Qui Nhon - Nha Trang : Morning visit local market and Cham Museum. Continue to Nha Trang with stops en route. On arrival transfer to hotel. Overnight Nha Trang.



Day 09 : Nha Trang

Morning visit Oceanography Institute with boat trip to outlying islands. Afternoon visit to Long Son Pagoda, Po Nagar Cham Towers and the Dam Market. Overnight Nha Trang.

Day 10 : Nha Trang - Dalat : Continue journey to Dalat with stop in Phan Rang to visit Po Klong Giara Cham Towers. Arrive in Dalat, transfer to hotel. Overnight Dalat.

Day 11 : Dalat : Visit Thien Vien Truc Lam, Bao Dai's Summer Palace, XQ embroidery workshop, city flower garden, local waterfalls. Take a journey to visit ancient railway station and take short journey to discover Dalat's suburban areas. Rest of day free. Overnight Dalat.



Day 12 : Dalat - Ho Chi Minh City : Drive to Ho Chi Minh City with stop at local waterfall. En route to visit local tea plantation and factory in Bao Loc. Transfer to hotel. Overnight Ho Chi Minh City.



Day 13 : Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi Tunnels. Drive to Cu Chi Tunnels and discover the underground network built by Vietnamese in Vietnam-American War. Afternoon city tour

to visit Presidential Palace, Notre Dame Cathedral and Central Post Office. Final stop is Ben Thanh Market. Enjoy dinner cruise on Saigon River. Overnight Ho Chi Minh City.



Day14 : Depart Ho Chi Minh City : At leisure until airport transfer for onward flight.
